The Glynwood Harvest Farmer Award recognizing a leader in the farm community who has developed cutting edge approaches to production, processing, marketing or distribution.

The Glynwood Harvest Connecting Communities, Farmers and Food Award recognizing outstanding work done by individuals, businesses or organizations that link farmers and the broader community to strengthen a regional food system.

The Glynwood Harvest Wave of the Future Award recognizing innovative approaches to address the critical challenges facing our food system.

The Glynwood Harvest Good Food for Health Award recognizing work at the forefront of creating ways to use sustainable, regionally-produced food to improve the health of children, the elderly, and consumers that traditionally do not have access to fresh, healthy food.
