Glynwood created the Harvest Awards program in 2003 to help identify and disseminate “best practice” ideas and to inspire others to take action within their own communities. ### Award Categories in 2009

We are particularly interested in projects that demonstrate one or more of the following:

- farmer-led collaborative marketing and distribution systems
- innovative policy models and grassroots advocacy on behalf of family farms and sustainable food production
- the advancement of agriculture in underserved communities
- the key roles being played by young leaders
- innovative approaches to the production, marketing and distribution of pastured livestock, including the distribution of local protein to restaurants and other institutions

This year's Awards categories are:

**The Glynwood Harvest Farmer Award** recognizing a leader in the farm community who has developed cutting edge approaches to production, processing, marketing or distribution.

**The Glynwood Harvest Connecting Communities, Farmers and Food Award** recognizing outstanding work done by individuals, businesses or organizations that link farmers and the broader community to strengthen a regional food system.

**The Glynwood Harvest Wave of the Future Award** recognizing innovative approaches to address the critical challenges facing our food system.

**The Glynwood Harvest Good Food for Health Award** recognizing work at the forefront of creating ways to use sustainable, regionally-produced food to improve the health of children, the elderly, and consumers that traditionally do not have access to fresh, healthy food.
